Facilitate the Commission's protection of utility consumers through the establishment and enforcement of:



Number of Filings before UTC Over 5-Year Period








Subject Matters Before the UTC Calendar Year 2003*








Subject Matters Before the UTC Over Time







Number of Applications for Transfer of Property




Filings Opened by Industry Over Time







FTE Usage by Industry Category FY 2001-2003








FTE Usage by Industry Category FY 2003-2005 To Date








Staff Average Monthly FTE 2002 and 2003

Evaluations Completed On Time in 2003: 100%



- Acclimate one new support person & one new attorney.
- Need to share and gain acceptance by division staff of AGMAP-tracked data.
- High workload expected in 2004 due to several major cases in Energy, and continued high workload in Telecommunications.
- Devise ways to better track constituent correspondence and informal client advice.





- Satisfactory outcomes on a number of large rate cases.
 - Avista Utilities petition for recovery of \$196 million in deferred power costs. Settled for 90%, spread over at least a 3-year longer period.
 - Avista Utilities interim and general (18%) rate increase requests of \$63.6 million. Settled for \$45.7 million.
 - Puget Sound Energy interim rate relief request and general (~16%) rate increase requests of \$314.2 million. Settled for \$94.6 million.
 - Olympic Pipeline general rate increase (76%) request of \$24.6 million. Relief granted in the amount of \$367,643 (2.5%).
 - Qwest DEX Transfer of Property Application
