Secondary legislation

- Based on the Power Sector Law, ERE has an obligation to complete all the secondary legislation
- During this period, ERE has made progress on this matter



The new acts approved:

- Licenses
 - License for Import of Electricity
 - License for supply of electricity to tariff customers
 - License for Qualified Supplier to supply the Eligible Customer
- Contracts of electricity supply for Household and Non-household customers (that are implemented by January 2006)



Continues the support and collaboration with USAID in this process.



- **The need for harmonization of the Legislation to be able to implement the Transitory Market Model and opening of the Electricity Market in Albania**
- **Compliance with the requirements of the ESCEE Treaty (signed between the EU and Regional countries)**



- **Amendments in the primary legislation (Power Sector Law)**
- **Changes in the secondary legislation (act and by laws approved by ERE)**





- KESH, Public Generation Company (Generation and Distribution activities)
- TSO, Transmission system Operator functioning as an independent company
- Other private small operators (Small local IPP licensed by ERE that sell the generated electricity to KESH with regulated price by the Regulator)



- Crises of Electricity faces by the end of 2005
- Analysis of the crises
- Steps taken to overcome the lack of electricity



- **Improvement of the situation**
- **Imports by KESH from the regional countries**
- **Steps to be taken in the future (metering system and targets to be reached)**
