- 1871 Railroad and Warehouse Commission
- 1913 Illinois Public Utilities Act
- 1997 Electric Restructuring
- 2007 Modernization
 - Illinois Power Agency
 - Renewable and Efficiency Portfolio Standards
- 2008 2013
 - Expedited Transmission Review
 - Wind Incentives: standardized taxes, high impact business
 - Smart Grid
 - Efficiency as a Resource
 - Gas Safety Infrastructure Investments





Illinois Commerce Commission

- Five (5) commissioners
 - Quasi Judicial decision making
- Authorization to employ 270 staff
 - Advocates
 - Enforcement
- Annual budget of approximately \$132 million
- Public Utilities Operations Budget of \$30M
- Offices in Springfield (State Capitol) and Chicago


