AN ELIGIBLE CONSUMER, IN ORDER TO MEET

HIS/HER REQUIREMENTS FOR ELECTRICAL

POWER, CAN ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH

ANY ELIGIBLE LICENSED LOCAL OR

INTERNATIONAL SUPPLIER.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY



>ANNUAL CONSUMPTION IN EXCESS OF 100 GWH SUPPORTED BY ELECTRICITY BILLS FOR ONE YEAR

> THE COMPANY/CONSUMER SHOULD HAVE NO DEBTS WITH THE DISTRIBUTION COMPANY



>TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH AN ELIGIBLE SUPPLIER, LOCAL OR INTERNATIONAL, THAT HAS BEEN ISSUED A LICENSE BY ERE

>THE RATES ARE NEGOTIATED BY THE PARTIES AND SPECIFIED IN THE POWER PURCHASING CONTRACT

>TO CONTACT WITH A GENERATING PUBLIC COMPANY THAT CAN SUPPLY EMERGENCY ELECTRICAL POWER



THE DUTIES OF THE ELIGIBLE CONSUMER

- THE CONSUMER WILL NOT RECEIVE ELECTRICITY FROM KPGJ OR DDC, BUT MAY CONTACT THEM TO PURCHASE EMERGENCY POWER
- CONTACT OST TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES
- INFORM OST OF THE DURATION AND SUPPLY OF REQUIRED POWER
- RETURING TO THE SYSTEM AS A TARIFF CONSUMER INCURS CERTAIN PENALITIES

ERE'S EXPERIENCE WITH ELIGIBLE

- THE FOLLOWING COMPANIES HAVE APPLIED TO ACQUIRE THE ELIGIBLE CONSUMER STATUS: DARFO ALBANIA SH.P.K AND KURUM SH.P.K
- BOTH WERE GRANTED REQUESTED STATUS
- HOWEVER, THEY DO NOT OPERATE AS ELIGIBLE CONSUMERS
- DIFFICULTIES IN CONTRACTING FK

DIFFICULTIES IN CONFORMING TO THE STATUS REQUIREMENTS



- CONTRATING WITH ELIGIBLE SUPPLIERS HAS NOT BEEN FULLY IMPLEMENTED (CURRENTLY ONLY ONE ELIGIBLE SUPPLIER IS LICENSED)
- CONFUSING THE STATUS OF AN ELIGIBLE CONSUMER WITH THE IMPORTING BUSINESS
- ELIGIBLE CONSUMERS TRY TO SIGN CONTRACTS WITH INTERNATIONAL SUPPLIERS, WHICH IS THE SAME AS IMPORTING ELECTRICITY
- ELIGIBLE CONSUMERS HAVE APPLIED FOR THE STATUS OF ELIGIBLE SUPPLIER (WHICH CONFLICTS WITH THE CIVIL CODE, I.E. THE MERGING OF A CONSUMER AND A SUPPLIER; THIS MEANS THAT THERE WILL BE NO PARTIES IN THE CONTRACT WITH AN ELIGIBLE SUPPLIER, AND KC HONORS ONE CONTRACT SIGNED BY ONE PARTY, ONE COMPANY
- ENFORCING ERE'S DECISON IS DELAYED, THIS CONSUMER CONTINUES TO OPERATE AS ELIGIBLE CONSUMER AND ELIGIBLE SUPPLIER

THE NEED FOR ERE REGULATION



- MAKE CHANGES TO THE REGULATIONS, WHICH GOVERN ELIGIBLE CONSUMERS, TO CONFORM TO THE EU GUIDELINES AND OTHER ACTS RELATED TO THE REGIONAL ENERGY MARKET
- STREAMLINE THE RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ELIGIBLE CONSUMERS AFTER THEY HAVE RECEIVED THEIR STATUS, IN TERMS OF:
 - > THE TIMEFRAME OF EXECUTING ERE'S DECISION (ONE YEAR PERIOD)
 - REASONS FOR REVOKING THE ELIGIBLE CONSUMER STATUS, WHICH MIGHT INCLUDE:
 - ELIGIBLE CONSUMER DOES NOT IMPLEMENT THE DECISION
 - > WISHES TO SURRENDER ITS STATUS
 - > DOES NOT PROVIDE THE ANNUAL OUTPUT REQUIRED BY LAW
