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Key Events and Activities

- Continuation of the process of institutional and legislative approximation to the EU
- Macedonia's responses to the "EU Membership Candidacy Questionnaire" were submitted to the EU Commission in Brussels on 14th of February 2005

Regulations

- ➤ Amendment of the Energy Law May, 2005
 - Regulates relations among participants in the electricity and gas markets
 - Stipulates the threshold and conditions for market opening
 - Prohibition of subventions among consumer categories
 - Public service obligations
 - Harmonization with the EU legislation
- ➤ Grid Code June, 2005
- ➤ Market Code June, 2005
- ➤ Preparation of the new Energy Law by end of 2005

The Rulebook on the Method and Conditions for Regulating Electricity Prices

- ➤ Adopted and published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia #95/04 on December 31, 2004
- ➤ Provides incentive based regulation in the electricity sector, enabling efficiency increase, decrease in losses and incentives for investment in the sector
- ➤ Methodologies applied in the Rulebook:
 - For transmission of electricity
 - ✓ Revenue cap method
 - For distribution of electricity
 - ✓ Hybrid method (Revenue cap and Price cap method)
 - For generation of electricity for tariff consumers
 - ✓ Revenue cap method

Current Activities

- ➤ Preparation of a *Tariff system for the electricity sector*
- Preparation of the Rulebook for the method and conditions for regulating natural gas prices
- Preparation of the Rulebook for the method and conditions for regulating district heating prices
- Preparation of a Tariff system for the district heating sector
- ➤ Preparation of the Rulebook for the method, conditions and procedure of issuing licenses (in cooperation with Pierce Atwood)

Reforms in the Electricity Sector (1/2)

- ➤ Unbundling of the "Elektrostopanstvo na Makedonija" a joint stock, state-owned company for generation, transmission and distribution of electricity into two companies (March, 2004):
 - AD MEPSO transmission system owner, system operator, market operator and wholesale supplier
 - AD ESM generation, distribution and supply of electricity
- ➤ Unbundling of the AD ESM (July, 2005):
 - ESM Generation
 - ESM Distribution and Supply

Reforms in the Electricity Sector (2/2)


- ➢ Government Decision adopted on 26th January 2005 initiated the process of *Privatization* of the <u>Electric Power Company of Macedonia</u> − A Joint Stock Company for Power Generation, Distribution and Supply, in state ownership, Skopje
 - up to 51% of the stock is to be sold to a strategic investor
 - the sale is to be carried out through a tender procedure which will also include a prequalification phase

Electricity Market Participants (1/2)

- ➤ Generation of electricity:
 - Regulated generation (AD ESM)
 - Distributed generation
 - Independent power producers (IPP)
- >Transmission of electricity:
 - Transmission Owner (TO)
 - System Operator (SO)
 - Market Operator (MO)
 - Wholesale Supplier for Tariff Customers (WS)

Electricity Market Participants (2/2)

- ➤ Distribution of electricity:
 - Distribution Owner (DO)
 - Distribution System Operator (DSO)
 - Retail Supplier for Tariff Customers (RS)
- ➤ Eligible Customers
- ➤ Tariff Customers
- >Traders





Reforms in the Gas Sector

- Separation of the public services from the commercial activities
- Separation of the ownership of the transport infrastructure from the transport operation and transport system operation of natural gas as a public service
- Formation of an independent company for transport services under regulated conditions
- Granting concessions for gasification, distribution and supply of tariff consumers for a specified territory and determined period for investors

Gas Market Participants

- ➤ Transportation of Natural Gas:
 - Transportation
 - System Operator (SO)
- ➤ Distribution of and Supply with Natural Gas:
 - Distribution of Natural Gas
 - Supply with Natural Gas for Tariff Customers (STC)
- ➤ Eligible and Tariff Customers
- ➤ Direct and Distributed Customers
- ➤ Trade and import
