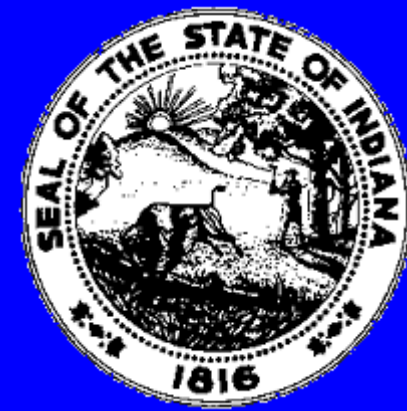

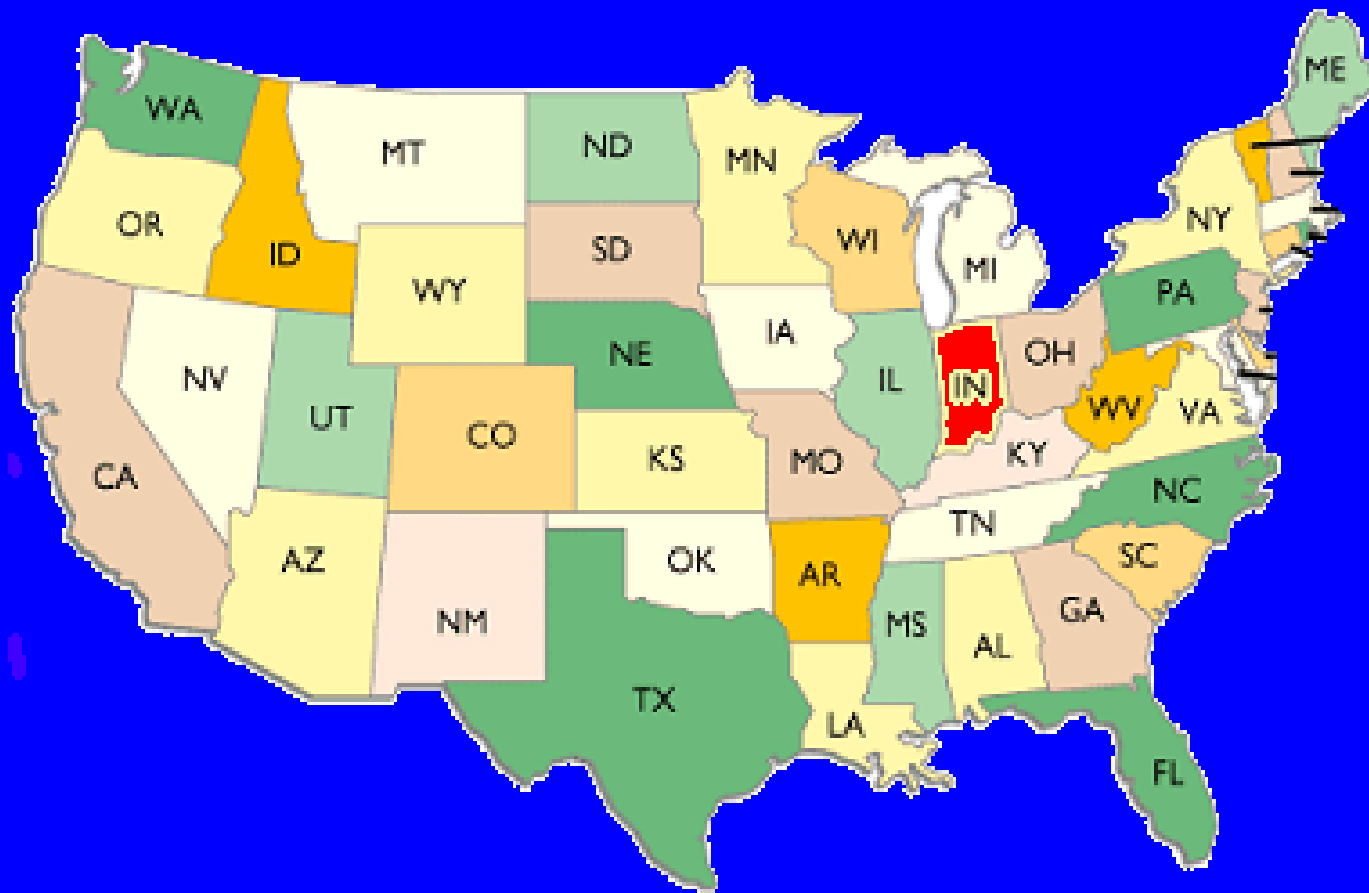

- Support and clerical staff



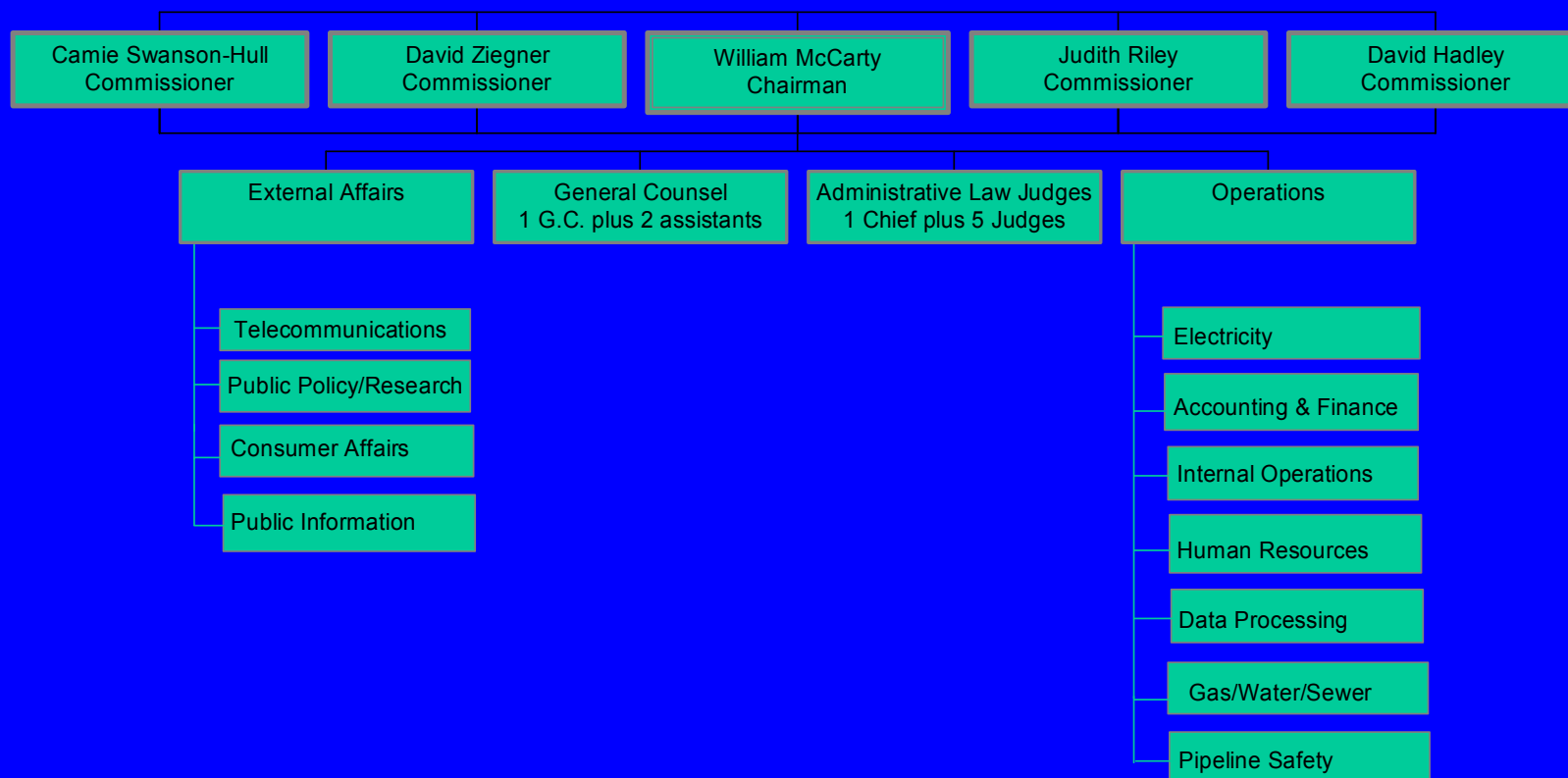
IURC Commissioners

- No more than three (3) from same party
- Staggered terms
- Qualifications

Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission





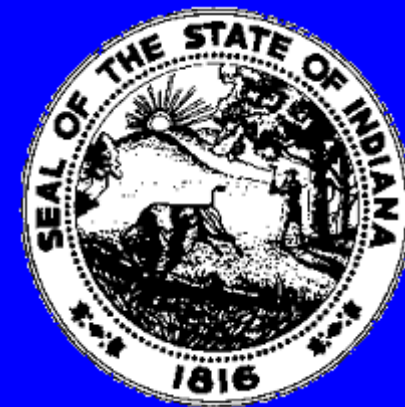
Decision Making Process

- Interaction with Staff



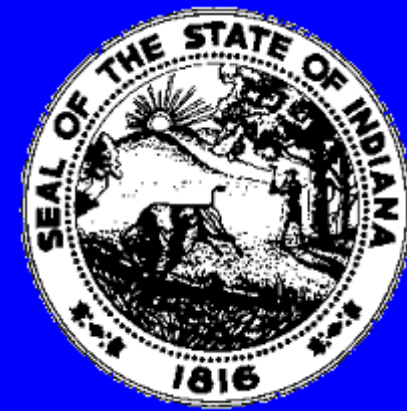
Financing the IURC
