Current Rates



- Beyond considering the cost of service, rates should:
 - Protect consumers from monopoly pricing
 - Take into account government policies for principal consumers
 - Take into account government policies for possible subventions
- Rates are transparent

Differences/Growth



- When price is lower than cost
 - Increase the price of energy for certain consumers, to match its cost plus a reasonable profit for the company
- Government policies are approved and supported through international studies and institutions

Approval of Pricing for Small HPPs and TSO



- > Cost plus a profit
- > Transmission charge = cost
 - ✓ TSO will be public (joint-stock company) and the charge for transmission will cover its respective operating costs and necessary investments
