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Transparency of the NCC's Activities

- The main principles of the NCC's activities
 - transparency and publicity of decision-taking.
- The process of the decision - taking :
 - The preparation for the NCC meetings
 - The meetings (or consultations) of NCC
 - Formalization of decisions (minutes and orders)

All NCC meetings are public

- The preparation for the NCC meetings:
 - The departments have to get the permission from one of the Commissioners to present the question on the meeting
 - The departments have to give the material to the Public Information Department (PID) one week before the meeting.
 - PID prepares the agenda of the meeting and gives it to the Chairmen to sign.
 - All material of the meeting is put on the website. Only interested institutions are informed directly.

All NCC meetings are public

- The meeting of NCC :
 - The meetings are recorded.
 - The minutes of the meetings are written up.
 - All participants have to register.
- After 3 days the minute should be prepared, agreeded with departments and signed by the Chairman.

The process of voting

- On each question Commissioners have to vote.
- The decision is made if 4 Commissioners participated in the meeting and the majority voted “for”.
- It is indicated in the minute who voted “against” and the main arguments for this are outlined.

Public information and relations with mass media

- All decisions are put on the website.
- On more important questions PID is preparing press releases.
- Journalists can participate in the meetings.
- Residents can call to departments directly and receive answers on simple questions.
- Residents have to prepare a written request if the question is complicated and requires the deeper analysis.
