

Resolution Honoring Commissioner Anne George of Connecticut

WHEREAS, Commissioner Anne George was first appointed to the Connecticut Department of Public Utility Control in July 2003 and was reappointed for a four-year term in 2007; *and*

WHEREAS, Commissioner George is an alumnus of the University of Maryland, College Park, and received her Juris Doctorate from Georgetown University; *and*

WHEREAS, As a NARUC member, Commissioner George embraced opportunities to get involved, serving as President of the New England Conference of Public Utilities and as a member of NARUC's Task Force on Climate Policy; *and*

WHEREAS, Commissioner George was an active member of the NARUC Committee on Electricity, serving first as its Vice Chair before becoming Chairman in January 2008; *and*

WHEREAS, As Chairman of the Electricity Committee, Commissioner George oversaw a packed agenda during the February 2008 Winter Committee Meetings, bringing in a standing-room only crowd to hear stellar discussions; *and*

WHEREAS, During her chairmanship, Commissioner George testified before Congress this past summer on Nuclear Waste issues, and testified a number of times in her capacity as a commissioner on the Connecticut Dept. of Public Utility Control; *and*

WHEREAS, Her interest in energy matters led to her service on the Board of the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative; *and*

WHEREAS, Commissioner George in October left the Connecticut Department to become the new Vice President of External Relations of ISO-New England, taking responsibility for the ISO's corporate communications and working with regulatory authorities; *and*

WHEREAS, Commissioner George's energetic leadership of the Electricity Committee and her enthusiastic presence throughout NARUC will be greatly missed by the Board and her NARUC colleagues; *now, therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, That the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners, convened at its 2008 Annual Meeting in New Orleans, Louisiana, extends and expresses its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Anne George and conveys its best wishes in all her future endeavors.
