

Resolution Honoring Greta Joy Dicus of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission

WHEREAS, Greta Joy Dicus served with distinction as a member of the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) from February 1996 to June 2003, including a period in 1999 as Chairman; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Dicus served as the NRC's liaison to the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) for most all of her term on the Commission; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Dicus regularly attended and participated in NARUC meetings, engaging in candid discussions and sharing her enlightening perspectives on the work of the NRC; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Dicus has been recognized as a leader in the field of radiation safety and protection, as evidenced by awards she has received, including the prestigious Gerald S. Parker award from the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Dicus has been active within the field of radiological protection internationally, and serves as a member of the International Commission on Radiological Protection for a term that extends to July 2005; now therefore be it
