WHEREAS, Jessica is always unfailingly charming, courteous and vivacious in face to face encounters carrying out her politically sophisticated and challenging lobbying duties; *and*

WHEREAS, Jessica leaves behind a NARUC Washington Action Orient Express Program, a legislative lobbying program that is dramatically more effective than these programs were when she first joined NARUC five years ago; *now therefore be it*
