*Whereas* Commissioner Bailey was an active member of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (“NARUC”), serving on the Electricity Committee, the Subcommittee on Nuclear Issues-Waste Disposal, and the Critical Infrastructure Committee;

*Whereas* Commissioner Bailey was an active participant in the Nuclear Waste Strategy Coalition;

*Whereas* Commissioner Bailey never liked to miss a Monday for fried shrimp at the Captains;
