

Resolution Honoring J. Paul Morgan

WHEREAS, J. Paul Morgan promoted the importance of regulation as Director General of the Office of Utilities Regulation of Jamaica from December 2002 to May 2008, as Deputy Director General for two to three year terms, and as a leading member of the project team that established the regulatory agency in Jamaica (the Office of Utilities Regulation began operations in January 1997); *and*

WHEREAS, Mr. Morgan served the Organization of Caribbean Utility Regulators (OCUR) as Chairman from November 2004 to November 2006 and as Vice Chairman from July 2002 to November 2004 and from November 2007 to May 2008; *and*

WHEREAS, Mr. Morgan demonstrated his commitment to improving global regulatory practices as Co-Vice Chair of the NARUC Committee on International Relations (IRC) from 2004 – 2008; *and*

WHEREAS, As Co-Vice Chair of the IRC, Mr. Morgan worked relentlessly and successfully to improve NARUC's international outreach and promote the exchange of best practices in energy regulation; *and*

WHEREAS, Mr. Morgan played a vital role in NARUC's Global Regulatory Network Program and supported a number of joint workshops and training sessions between OOCUR and NARUC members; *and*

WHEREAS, Mr. Morgan worked with NARUC on the successful implementation of the World Forum on Energy Regulation III (October 2006) that explored themes and issues facing regulators from developed, transition, and developing countries; *and*

WHEREAS, Mr. Morgan showed his true commitment to NARUC by attending nearly every meeting during the past five years and engaging U.S. Commissioner's interest in global activities; *now, therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC), convened at its 2008 Summer Meetings in Portland, Oregon, expresses its sincere appreciation to Director General Morgan for his years of dedicated public service to the Association; *and be it further*

RESOLVED, That the Committee on International Relations and all NARUC members convey their best wishes for Mr. Morgan in all of his future endeavors.
