



## PowerConnect: Grid Resilience Support Technical Assistance for Public Utility Commissions

With the support from the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Electricity, *PowerConnect* is a time-limited technical assistance initiative led by NARUC to support state utility commissions in implementing grid resilience strategies within their jurisdictions. Through this offering, members can submit specific questions or challenges related to resilience planning, regulation, or implementation via a simple online form. NARUC staff will then connect them directly with subject-matter experts who can provide targeted, timely responses.

This initiative recognizes the urgent nature of resilience-related decision-making and the complexities of evaluating resilience investments. *PowerConnect* is designed for short-term, high-impact support — ideal for regulators seeking quick insights, best practices, or guidance on navigating resilience investments, filings, and planning tools.

The goal is to reduce barriers, accelerate knowledge sharing, and empower commissions with the information they need.

NARUC will match Public Utility Commissions with subject matter experts with assistance with potential topical issues, such as:

- Definitions of grid resilience that are actional and unique to jurisdiction,
- resilience metrics,
- valuation methodologies,
- risk assessment frameworks,
- resilience technologies,
- resilience investments and regulatory considerations,
- rate recovery and cost-benefit analysis
- integrating resilience into broader grid planning efforts

This support is available through August and is offered at no cost to NARUC members.
