

Resolution Regarding Joint or Coordinated FCC and State Audits

WHEREAS, *Both the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and State regulatory commissions are interested in the costs incurred by companies for products and services and the appropriate assignment of those costs; and*

WHEREAS, *The staffs of both the FCC and State regulatory commissions conduct audits of the operations of companies under their respective jurisdictions; and*

WHEREAS, *There may be benefits to be derived from joint or coordinated audits of companies regulated by both entities; now, therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, *That the Executive Committee of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners, assembled at its 1990 Winter Committee Meeting in Washington, D.C., urges the FCC and State regulatory commissions to participate, whenever feasible, in joint or coordinated audits of companies regulated by both entities.*
