







A reasonable approach to privacy

Arcadia Power may share certain data with third parties, per our privacy policy:

- Affiliates. We may share Personal Information within Arcadia Power among our various subsidiaries and affiliates.
- Service Providers. We rely on third-party service providers to perform a variety of services on our behalf. To do so, we may need to share your Personal Information with them.
- Other Parties When Required by Law or as Necessary to Protect Our Sites. There may be instances when we disclose your Personal Information to other parties:
 - To comply with the law or respond to legal process or a request for cooperation by a government entity
 - To prevent fraud or verify and enforce compliance with the policies governing our Sites
 - Where permitted by law, to protect the rights, property, or safety of Arcadia Power, or any of our respective affiliates, business partners, customers or employees
- Other Parties In Connection With A Corporate Transaction. We may disclose your Personal Information to a third party in the event we sell or transfer all or a portion of a business or our assets to a third party, such as in connection with a merger or in the event of a bankruptcy reorganization or liquidation.
- Other Parties With Your Consent At Your Direction. In addition to the disclosures described in this Privacy Policy, we may share Personal Information about you with third parties when you consent to or request such sharing. For example, in order to fulfill enrollment in our services, we must share your Personal Information with your local utility company. We also may share your Personal Information with third parties that provide products or services that may be of interest to you and you may opt-out of the sharing of this information.
- Aggregated and Non-Personal Information. We also may share data that is not reasonably linkable to a particular consumer or device (for example, information that has been aggregated with other records) for general business purposes. We may also share aggregated or anonymized information, which may be shared with third parties without your consent. For example, we may share your aggregated and anonymous information to publish trends about energy use and conservation and help utility companies provide demand-response services.
