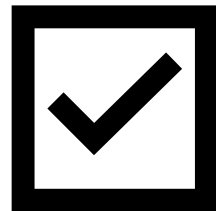

- What policies has your state adopted about large load customers?

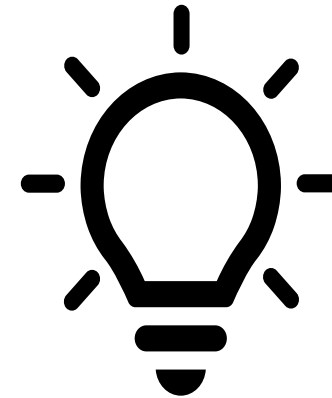
# Approaches
