Nevada PUC Chair Williamson Appointed to NARUC Board of Directors

WASHINGTON (June 27, 2022) — The National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners welcomes a new member to its Board of Directors, with the appointment of Commissioner Hayley Williamson, chair of the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada.

Williamson has served as a commissioner at the PUCN since 2019 and served previously as the senior general counsel and acting general counsel. She has a bachelor's degree from the University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point, a juris doctorate from Vermont Law School and a Master of Philosophy degree from the University of Cambridge.

"I am humbled and honored to be joining the NARUC Board. I appreciate all of the hard work being done by the Board and look forward to serving amongst my fellow commissioners," said Williamson.

As the supervisory body, the board oversees the Association's general and financial functions and approves resolutions that serve as the Association's policy.
