

Resolution Honoring Commissioner Andrew Giles Fay

Whereas Commissioner Andrew Giles Fay was first appointed to the Florida Public Service Commission by Governor Rick Scott in February 2018 and was reappointed by Governor Ron DeSantis to a term ending January 1, 2026;

Whereas Commissioner Fay was elected by his colleagues to serve as chairman of the Florida PSC from January 2022 through January 2024;

Whereas Commissioner Fay served the Florida PSC with distinction and worked tirelessly and brought great attention to detail on the legal and technical utility regulatory issues before the Commission;

Whereas Commissioner Fay serves NARUC as a member of the Board of Directors and as the chair of the Critical Infrastructure Committee, where he leads a national effort to enhance the resiliency and reliability of America’s energy grid;

Whereas Commissioner Fay also serves NARUC as a member of the Subcommittee on Education and Research, where he is the lead faculty member of the nation’s premier utility rate development program, also known as Rate School;

Whereas Commissioner Fay was named by his peers as one of Florida Trend’s “Legal Elite Government and Nonprofit Lawyers” and has also been recognized as the “Government Attorney of the Year” for his work on a wide array of issues including assisting victims of the attack on the Pulse Nightclub in Orlando while serving Florida’s Attorney General;

Whereas Commissioner Fay was also recently appointed to advise the Florida Bar Board of Governors on the use of Artificial Intelligence within the judicial system; *and*

Whereas Commissioner Fay is a proud Seminole, having earned his bachelor’s and juris doctor from Florida State University. While in law school, Commissioner Fay served as the editor-in-chief of the *Florida State Business Review* and was also recognized nationally for his work in public service while representing the law school as Student Bar Association President; *now therefore be it*
