The National Council on Electricity Policy Released a New Transmission Resource Library for Electric System Decision-Makers and Practitioners

WASHINGTON (June 10, 2026) — The National Council on Electricity Policy has released a new resource library designed to provide transmission-specific resources developed by NCEP member organizations in a central repository focused on electricity system policy, planning and regulation.

The library compiles reports, webinar presentations and recordings, webpages, references and policy documents spanning the topic areas of transmission planning, permitting, operations and costs in a mini database. It includes resources that cover every aspect of the transmission life cycle, facilitating an all-encompassing education from one location. Items can be filtered by author, topic, resource type and year published. To enable more intuitive navigation, the library offers in-depth definitions of each transmission topic area.

“The Transmission Resource Library reflects the collaborative efforts of NCEP member organizations to make high-quality transmission resources more accessible to state entities working in the electricity sector,” said NARUC Senior Policy Advisor Hyleah O’Quinn. “By bringing together decades of research, technical expertise and educational materials in a single location, this library provides a valuable starting point to navigating the increasingly complex transmission landscape.”

This new library aims to promote more effective and widespread use of current electric transmission research assembled by NCEP organizations. It also emphasizes transmission topic areas where there is a need for additional materials that cater to a decision-maker and practitioner audience.
